

1. Fundamentals of Hospice Palliative Care:

An introductory Multidisciplinary Palliative Care Education (formerly Level I Program). This is an 8 week (3 hour classes) standardized curriculum, recommended **for ALL Health Care Providers**, and anyone interested in becoming a hospice palliative care volunteer. The Fundamentals program is based on *A Model to Guide Hospice Palliative Care, 2002*, specifically the Domains of issues associated with illness and bereavement.

2. Advanced Hospice Palliative Care Education (AHPCE)

This course is for Personal Support Workers, Hospice Volunteers and other unregulated healthcare providers who have **completed** The Fundamentals of Hospice Palliative Care . The AHPCE course is designed to align with *The Fundamentals of Hospice Palliative Care 2002*. This is an 8-week (3 hour classes) course involving a standardized curriculum.
