



Since 1988, Hospice Peterborough has created a safe, comfortable and welcoming environment for clients, staff and volunteers offering a variety of community programs and services. In April 2019 Hospice Peterborough opened a brand new facility and expanded programming to include a Hospice Residence offering 24/7 end of life care. In January 2021, the Board of Directors approved Hospice Peterborough's new Strategic Plan for 2021-25 identifying 4 strategic priority areas: Trusted Leadership in Hospice Palliative Care, Exemplary Programs and Services, Organizational Excellence and Financial Sustainability. While the Organization's programs and services adapted to the new reality dictated by COVID-19, Hospice Peterborough achieved Accreditation (with an outstanding 98.67% ) by Hospice Palliative Care Ontario in 2021.
