# The focus of this course is on the pharmacological management of pain. Pain assessment,

management, and evaluation are foundational skills for nurses working in any practice setting. EPM aims to equip nurses with a foundational knowledge base and skills around pain management, from a palliative care approach, that can be applied to your practice.

### **EPM Course**

You will have a minimum of six weeks to complete the course. To receive an EPM certificate, you must:
